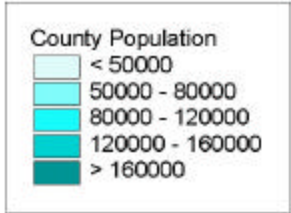
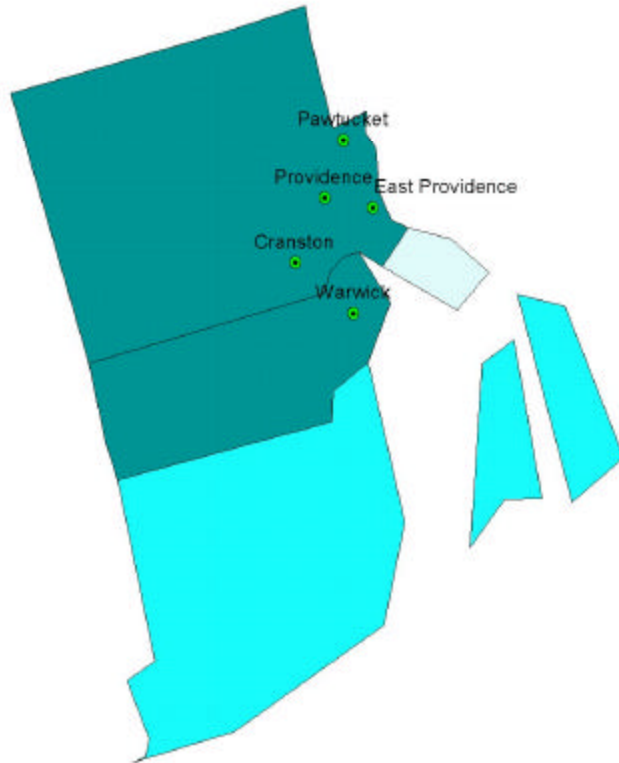


Rhode Island State Profile of Exposure to Coal-Fired Power Plants
