

- **Interim:** N/A
- **Final:** 105 MW generated from renewable energy resources by the two major utilities in the state, MidAmerican Energy and Alliant Energy Interstate Power and Light, based on peak demand in 1990 (already met)

**Economy-wide requirement:** N/A

**Point of regulation:** Retail sales – Each utility is responsible for a fixed volume of renewable energy, based on its share of retail peak demand in 1990

**Regulated entities:** MidAmerican Energy and Alliant Energy Interstate Power and Light

**Percent of retail sales covered by RPS:** 86%

**Implementing agency:** Iowa Utilities Board

**Enforcement mechanisms:** N/A
