ALTERNATIVE ENERGY PORTFOLIO STANDARD

Policy type

Renewable Portfolio Standard

Form of the standard

Energy-based

% of renewable energy required

Targets

- **Interim:** Incremental increases each year or each three years, beginning in 2007
- **Final:** 18% by 2021 (8% Tier I, 10% Tier II, 0.5% solar carve-out)

Economy-wide goal: Executive order establishing a 26% reduction by 2025 and 80% reduction by 2050, compared to 2005 levels

Point of regulation: Retail sales

Regulated entities: Public utilities, including Investor-owned utilities, and municipal utilities

Percent of retail sales covered by RPS: 98%

Implementing agencies: Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission; Department of Environmental Quality (environmental standard enforcement)

Enforcement mechanisms: The Commission conducts an annual review, and if it determines a regulated company failed to comply, the Commission imposes an alternative compliance payment.

Compliance flexibility and cost containment: Alternative Compliance Payments (ACP) of \$45 multiplied by the number of additional alternative energy credits needed to comply. Solar photovoltaic share: 200% market value of solar renewable energy credits sold. Electric generation suppliers may be excused by the Commission under force majeure.

Carve-outs and incentives: In addition to Tier I and Tier II, solar carve-out: 0.5% by 2020 and thereafter

Notable features: Beginning October 30, 2017, only solar PV systems in-state count towards compliance
